Camille SAINT-SAËNS (1835-1921) **Music for Wind Ensemble** Samson et Dalila **Orient et Occident**

Marche héroïque Band of the RAF College Jun Märkl



Camille Saint-Saëns was involved in every aspect of French music during his long lifetime, and his frequent travels led to a fascinating mixture of Western music with Moorish and African elements in works such as Orient et Occident and the Suite algérienne. Saint-Saëns wrote few works for winds, but the grand biblical themes of Samson et Dalila, patriotic military traditions and the dignity of a British coronation all lend themselves perfectly to arrangement. In The Carnival of the Animals, the roaring lions are superbly evocative; while his perspectives on English and Scottish dances in ballet movements from Henry VIII are brilliantly imaginative.

About Jun Märkl, Conductor

Jun Märkl is a highly respected interpreter of core Germanic repertoire and has become known for his refined and idiomatic explorations of the French Impressionists. He has been appointed principal guest conductor of the Residentie Orkest, The Hague for the 2020-21 season, and from 2021 the music director of the Malaysian Philharmonic Orchestra. Märkl has an extensive discography among the more than 50 albums he has recorded are the complete Schumann symphonies with the NHK Symphony; Mendelssohn and Wagner with the MDR Leipzig Radio Symphony; and works by Ravel, Messiaen, and a highly acclaimed Debussy series with Orchestre National de Lyon. He is currently working on a cycle of works by Saint-Saëns, R. Strauss and Hosokawa.

Key Features:

- Saint-Saëns only wrote four original works for military band, and he is of course far more renowned today for popular orchestral hits such as the Danse macabre and the Third ('Organ') Symphony. This release is a scintillating exploration of Saint-Saëns's music, putting famous classics such as The Carnival of the Animals next to less frequently heard marches and dances, all attired with fresh and invigorating new sounds.
- Jun Märkl has led numerous desirable recordings, becoming well known for his refined and idiomatic explorations of French music. His Saint-Saëns recordings for Naxos include the ballet Ascanio (8.574033), which is played with 'great panache and spirit, [and is] all hugely enjoyable' (Gramophone).
- MusicWeb International admired the 'elegant music making' in Märkl's recording of the Symphonic Poems (8.573745), and further orchestral works including the Suite algérienne (8.573732) had AllMusic.com concluding that he 'and the Basque National Orchestra are ideal interpreters of Saint-Saëns.
- Formed in 1920, the Band of the Royal Air Force College provides music for officer graduation parades at the RAF College as well as undertaking a diverse array of engagements in the UK and around the world. 2018 saw the Band undertake engagements celebrating the centenary of the Royal Air Force, including the RAF100 parade in London, the Service of Thanksgiving in Westminster Abbey and performances at The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo.

Francesco CAVALLI (1602–1676) **Ercole amante**

('Hercules in Love') Libretto by Francesco Buti

Francesco Cavalli, a natural successor to Monteverdi, was the most famous and influential Italian opera composer during the mid-17th century. Cardinal Mazarin, chief minister to the king, commissioned Cavalli to create a Parisian spectacle to celebrate the wedding of the 'Sun King' Louis XIV and the Infanta of Spain. Ercole amante ('Hercules in Love') was the flattering subject chosen for this regal extravaganza combining larger-than-life characters with mythology, and genuine human emotions with natural and cosmic phenomena. The result is a sumptuous Baroque spectacle, conceived on a vast scale in this lavish production by directors Valérie Lesort and Christian Hecq.



Key Features:

- Forgotten since its premiere in 1662, Ercole amante is such a uniquely grand and expensive conception that it was revived only as recently as 1981 and is still an extreme rarity. This 2019 Opéra Comique production is both musically and visually spectacular, entering into the spirit of breath-taking Baroque opulence and atmosphere, but with plenty of fresh fantasy and entertainingly modern touches to make its vast scale accessible to a wide public.
- Critical admiration for this production was extensive: 'Valérie Lesort and Christian Hecq have found the perfect balance between fidelity to the libretto and its Baroque character and the need to simplify it technically and in dramaturgy. In the pit, Raphaël Pichon and his Ensemble Pygmalion bring all their knowledge and all the possibilities of their array of instruments to give



sparkle to every detail of this opulent score which overflows with invention. The chorus is remarkable for its cohesion, precision and intonation.' (Bachtrack.com)

'The cast was handpicked from strength. Nahuel di Pierro was superb in the title role. The voice has gained some wonderful resonance at the bottom, apparent as he descended to the sepulchral depths. Anna Bonitatibus brought her customary stylistic understanding to

Ludwig van BEETHOVEN (1770–1827) Piano Concertos Nos. 1 and 2

Igor Levit and Xiaohan Wang, Pianos Kölner Kammerorchester Helmut Müller-Brühl

Igor Levit made his recording debut with a performance of Beethoven's First Piano Concerto when he was 20 years old, long before he became a superstar of the classical music world and a major interpreter of Beethoven's music. The occasion was part of the series Das Meisterwerk ('The Masterpiece'), in which Levit was accompanied by the superb Cologne Chamber Orchestra conducted by Helmut Müller-Brühl. Evidence of what was to become the hallmark of Levit's Beethoven style, not least his distinctive fingering technique, is already apparent in this performance, in which the youthful spirits of both composer and performer are well matched. Performed in Cologne's Philharmonic Hall, it is the only commercially available recording to feature Levit with orchestra.

The album also contains a performance of Beethoven's Second Piano Concerto, with Xiaohan Wang as soloist. Both artists had secured this special performance opportunity as semi-finalists in the 2005 International Beethoven Competition Bonn.

About Igor Levit, Piano

Hailed by The New York Times as 'one of the essential artists of his generation', Igor Levit is the 2018 Gilmore Artist and Royal Philharmonic Society's 'Instrumentalist of the Year'. In the 2020-21 season, Levit is Artist in Residence with Bavarian Radio Symphony Orchestra. His solo disc of the five last Beethoven Sonatas both won the BBC Music Magazine Newcomer of the Year and the Royal Philharmonic Society's Young Artist Awards in 2014.

About Xiaohan Wang, Piano

Prize-winner of the Van Cliburn International Piano Competition and ARD International Music Competition, Xiaohan Wang has performed concerts in Europe, Russia, USA, Canada, Israel and Asia. He has collaborated with Hilary Hahn, Ning Feng, Misha Maisky, Qin Liwei, the Jerusalem Quartet, the Takács Quartet, the Tokyo Quartet, and the Juilliard Quartet. Wang is artistic director of the Arthur Rubinstein International Junior Piano Competition and the Singapore International Piano Competition.

Key Features:

- Recorded live in 2007, these performances celebrate the recording debuts of young talented artists who are laureates of the Beethoven Competition in Bonn, Germany. Each artist perform one of Beethoven's Piano Concertos, and this disc of the First and Second Piano Concertos feature Igor Levit (recipient of the International Beethoven Prize in 2019) and Xiaohan Wang, respectively.
- Upcoming releases will feature Henri Sigfridsson (Third Concerto), Norie Takahashi (Fourth Concerto) and David Kadouch (Fifth Concerto, 'Emperor').
- The presentation of the rising generation of young musicians has always been a particular concern of Helmut Müller-Brühl and many now wellknown soloists enjoyed their first success with the Cologne Chamber Orchestra. In 2001 the Orchestra won a Cannes Classical Award for its recording of Telemann's Darmstadt Overtures (Naxos 8.554244).



Inspired by the image of a violin melody 'flying off', Chinese-American composer Bright Sheng's virtuosic three-movement concerto Let Fly interweaves Chinese and Western classical elements. Vivid legends of astrological animals inform Zodiac Tales, a tour de force concerto for orchestra. Reflecting the city of Suzhou's ancient, continuous cultural heritage, traditional nostalgia fuses with contemporary rhythms in the exciting Suzhou Overture.

About Bright Sheng, Composer

Bright Sheng is one of the leading composers of our time, whose stage, orchestral, chamber and vocal works are performed regularly by the greatest performing arts institutions throughout North America, Europe and Asia. A MacArthur Fellow, Sheng has created an oeuvre with a strong synthesis of Western musical tradition which makes his work distinctive and original. He is currently the Leonard Bernstein Distinguished University Professor of Composition at the University of Michigan, and Sohmen Professor-at-Large at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology where, in 2011, he founded The Intimacy of Creativity - The Bright Sheng Partnership: Composers Meet Performers in Hong Kong.

- Sheng founded The Intimacy of Creativity a partnership programme devoted to promoting an intimate dialogue between composers and performers - and hosts world premiere performances by distinguished and up-and-coming composers. A retrospective album was released on 8.573614-15, with AllMusic.com commenting: 'the performance of the Cantus led here by conductor and American-based Chinese composer Bright Sheng is extraordinary: luminous, mystical, broad, and deep.' ★ ★ ★
- Praised by The Strad magazine, Dan Zhu is recognised as one of the finest musicians on the international stage today, performing internationally in North America, Europe and Asia. This programme portrays the 'birth' of the flute in France in the late 17th century and the following 40 years of its life as a new and fashionable instrument. A famous patron of the arts, King Louis XIV gathered elite composers and musicians to create the refinement. elegance and good taste that was demanded at his Paris Court. From the early petites pièces to more virtuoso suites and sonatas with their ornamented lyricism and grand dance rhythms, the mellow, robust and almost husky sounds of flutes from this period blend and weave around each other like the voices of two singers.

About Barthold Kuijken, Traverso

Barthold Kuijken is an eminent leader in the field of Early Music. A virtuoso traverso soloist, teacher and conductor, he has shaped the fields of historical flutes and historically informed performance over the last 40 years. A Flemish native of Belgium, Kuijken has widely performed and recorded the repertoire for the Baroque flute. Kuijken is the artistic director and conductor of the Indianapolis Baroque Orchestra.

About Immanuel Davis, Traverso

Immanuel Davis is one of the most versatile flautists of his generation. Equally at home on modern and Baroque flutes, Davis has performed as a soloist and chamber musician throughout the US and abroad. He has performed as a soloist and chamber player with Early Music ensembles such as Early Music New York, ARTEK, Lyra Baroque Orchestra, REBEL, Bach Society of Minnesota and Mercury Orchestra of Houston.

across the US, Europe, and Japan. Donald Livingston is sought after for his performance on harpsichord, fortepiano and organ, and collaborates with musicians from across the musical spectrum.

Social and musical life in Biedermeier Vienna during the first decade of the 19th century created a great demand for dances which took place in the residences of wealthy citizens. With their echoes of the Austrian countryside Schubert's folk-type *Ländler* are dances in 3/4 time, precursors of the waltz. Composed towards the end of his life when Schubert wrote his greatest music, the sets of 16 and 17 *Ländler* are notable for their melodic inventiveness. The 16 are dedicated to the ladies of Vienna and known as the *Wiener Damen-Ländler*, while the *Écossaises* were intended for facing lines of dancers rather than couples. Daniel Lebhardt relishes the joy and 'irresistible and sometimes quite delirious' ingenuity of these jewel-like dances.

About Daniel Lebhardt, Piano

Daniel Lebhardt was selected to be a Young Classical Artists Trust (YCAT) Artist in 2015 and is currently based in Birmingham. In 2014 Lebhardt won First Prize at the Young Concert Artists international auditions in Paris and New York. In 2016 he won Most Promising Pianist at the Sydney International Piano Competition. Recent highlights include his debut with the Hallé Orchestra playing Beethoven's *Piano Concerto No. 5*, and his concerto debuts at the Barbican and Birmingham Symphony Hall performing the same work. In 2020 he made his Ukrainian debut in recital in Kiev, subsequently receiving an immediate invitation to return for a performance of Rachmaninov's iconic *Piano Concerto No. 3*.


Kev Features:

- The new release is part of a series of albums in Naxos' new joint initiative with the UK's Royal Birmingham Conservatoire, presenting debut albums for outstanding students at the conservatoire.
- The disc also complements Daniel Lebhardt's previous recording of Schubert's 30 Minuets with Trios, D. 41, 8 Ländler, D. 378 and 5 Eccossaises, D. 697 (8.574145), released in December 2020.
- This collection of Schubert's rare piano works follows on the series of sonatas and other works recorded by Jenő Jandó. Of the complete *Impromptus* album (8.550260), *Fanfare* stated that here is 'an artist with keen musical insights and a seemingly effortless technical command'.
- Eldar Nebolsin has also recorded Piano Sonatas Nos. 4 and 13, and the Wanderer Fantasy (8.572459), which was a Classic FM Editor's Choice: 'Nebolsin's grasp of structure, simplicity of approach with clear, natural phrasing, and the song-like purity of the recorded sound make this a very special Schubert disc'.

Arthur SULLIVAN (1842–1900) Ballet Music

Soon after his return from studies in Leipzig, Sir Arthur Sullivan wrote his second work, *L'Île Enchantée*. This was a ballet score on the subject of a shipwrecked mariner which debuted at Covent Garden in the form of a divertissement at the end of Bellini's *La sonnambula*, where it was received with acclaim. This premiere recording restores passages Sullivan cut when presenting the work for concert performances. *Thespis*, a collaboration with W.S. Gilbert, is a flamboyant opera cum pantomime of which only fragments now remain – the work's lost ballet has been rediscovered and restored by Roderick Spencer and Selwyn Tillett.

Key Features:

- This release originally appeared on Marco Polo 8.223460, released in 1992. Other Naxos discs of music by Sir Arthur Sullivan included the *Overtures* to operas with W.S. Gilbert (8.554165), and the complete ballet to *Pineapple Roll* and the 'Irish' Symphony in E major (8.570351) that received a 10/10 score from ClassicsToday.com: 'a prime recommendation if you want to hear Sullivan's major orchestral work alongside many of his best tunes, but without the voices. Marvellous!'
- Andrew Penny has made over 50 recordings for the Naxos and Marco Polo labels. Much of the repertoire is British Music such as film scores by Vaughan Williams with the RTÉ Concert Orchestra (Coastal Command and 49th Parallel Prelude on 8.573658), described as 'brilliant' by Fanfare. He was awarded the MBE for services to music in the Queen's Birthday Honours of 2014, and was listed in the top 100 of the county's achievers in The Yorkshire Post in 2018.

Journeys Orchestral Music from Five Continents

Audun André Sandvik, Cello Norwegian Radio Orchestra • Miguel Harth-Bedoya

Peruvian-born, American-trained conductor Miguel Harth-Bedoya, is inspired to look at how music, like the poetic concept of peace, can unite the world. The idea behind *Journeys* is to create an example of that unity in a tangible form by bringing together music from every continent into one album. With works inspired by myths and mechanics, cosmic motion and human emotion, originating from Europe and the Americas to Africa, Asia and Australasia, the themes in this collection of world premiere recordings range as widely as their origins.

Key Features:

This unique programme of world premiere orchestral works is one with a mission. Based in Oslo, the home of the Nobel Peace Prize, conductor **Miguel Harth-Bedoya** and the **Norwegian Radio Orchestra** have sought to explore places that are not normally associated with symphonic music. All of these recordings are world premieres of works by living composers writing music for and connecting directly with the 21st century.

- The Norwegian Radio Orchestra's recordings include works by Celso Garrido-Lecca (8.573759), in which 'Miguel Harth-Bedoya leads us to the tender heart of Garrido-Lecca's music' (*Gramophone*), and 'You probably couldn't ask for a more persuasive interpreter than Miguel Harth-Bedoya, who leads [in] wholly winning performances of all four pieces. This is the sort of release that makes you want to hear more' (*ClassicsToday.com*).
- Harth-Bedoya is a frequent guest conductor worldwide, both in concert halls and opera houses. In 2015 he conducted the world premiere of Jennifer Higdon's first opera Cold Mountain at Santa Fe Opera, which was nominated for a GRAMMY Award.

Ottorino Respighi was in the vanguard of the 20th-century rebirth of Italian symphonic music. Famed for his Roman Trilogy, Respighi was also prominent in the synthesis of pre-Classical melodic styles and late-Romantic harmonies and textures. These are the elements that make the Ancient Airs and Dances so captivating and expressive, as Respighi draws on dances by 16th-century composers to brilliant effect. The Concerto all'antica is an early, beautifully poetic work that again draws on ancient styles, in a recording that uses the first printed critical edition of the work by Salvatore Di Vittorio, published in 2019.

Key Features:

Conductor Salvatorre Di Vittorio and the Chamber Orchestra of New York have an outstanding history of interpreting Respighi's music. Their release of Gli uccelli ('The Birds'), Trittico botticelliano and Suite in G major on 8.573168 'are performed in the most refined and transparent versions one can imagine' according to Pizzicato ($\star\star\star\star\star$).



- The world premiere recording of Respighi's Violin Concerto in A major (revised and completed by Di Vittorio) on 8.572332 was declared 'an essential issue' by Classical Net, and New York's WQXR Album of the Week: 'the concerto is somewhat reminiscent of Respighi's teacher Rimsky-Korsakov, but it also inhabits the lush, romantic sound world of Bruch and Brahms.'
- Davide Alogna also performed the world premiere recording of Castelnuovo-Tedesco's Violin Concerto No. 3 for Naxos (8.574003). Musica gave it 5 stars, with MusicWeb International commenting: 'we have here a fine enough performance for the work to be judged on its own merits and, whilst this Third Concerto is not in the league of the Second, it's a curiosity worth hearing.'







Previous releases featured Concertos Nos. 20 and 21 (8.573398), which was a Classic FM CD of the Week: 'It makes for a fascinating listen... exposing Mozart's melodies which are delivered with great precision and clarity here by Goldstein.'



- Vol. 2 included Concertos Nos. 23 and 24 (8.573736): 'Spirited playing and a perfectly mixed, subtly nuanced and transparent sound make these recordings a pure listening pleasure.'

Most recently they recorded a collection of rarities for string quartet by Beethoven (8.574051), celebrating the composer's 250th birth anniversary in 2020.

New Zealand String Quartet



Janáček's final decade saw an almost unprecedented creative renewal during which he wrote some of his greatest works. Among them were his chamber music masterpieces, the two String Quartets. The first was inspired by Tolstoy's novella The Kreutzer Sonata, a torrid tale of adultery and murder to which Janáček responded with music of increasingly frenzied passion. The second was subtitled Intimate Letters, a freely evolving work full of yearning and amorous defiance. Originally cast for four violins, the two youthful Sonnets date from 1875 and balance the archaisms of the first with the lyricism of the second.

Key Features:

- The New Zealand String Quartet (NZSQ) has been the country's leading chamber ensemble, with a distinguished catalogue of acclaimed recordings. Among these releases included Brahms String Quartets (8.573433 and 8.573454) in which a Fanfare reviewer exclaimed: 'These are absolutely scorchinghot, searing performances... These players are so disciplined, [and] so technically accomplished...that the sound they make is without a single blemish.'
- NZSQ's album of Alban Berg's and Hugo Wolf's pieces (8.557374) also received high praise from ClassicsToday.com: 'as you listen to these works afresh, you not only marvel at the individual players' virtuosity, but you also have to appreciate that the relatively warm yet pleasingly "edgy" quality to the sound and the oneness of spirit in the interpretations come from the highest-order functioning of the well-integrated collective parts of a mature, vital body'. The second volume of this series (Volume 1 is on 8.573995) visits 20th-century France, where the combination of trumpet and piano inspired music of ravishing beauty, intimacy and wit. Through the bluesy retrospection of Jean Hubeau's Sonata, the voluptuous rhapsody of Florent Schmitt's Suite and the avantgarde eclecticism of Antoine Tisné's Héraldiques, this album explores the quintessentially Gallic sonorities that came to redefine the instrument's voice for the modern era.

Key Features:

- Winner of the Prague Spring, Ellsworth Smith, Girolamo Fantini, Only Brass and Lieksa international trumpet competitions, Huw Morgan is principal trumpet of the Sinfonieorchester Basel, and a founder member of brass ensemble Septura. He can be heard on over 30 commercial recordings, including the ongoing Music for Brass Septet series on Naxos.
- Vol. 1 is available on 8.573995. The Art Music Lounge wrote: 'Morgan plays it with great elegance and a warm tone. We end with a trumpet transcription of three arias from György Ligeti's very strange opera, Mysteries of the Macabre. It's excellent and even funny music, of course... Morgan plays with a beautiful tone, as ever.'



Alexander Campkin is renowned as a leading young choral composer who has been commissioned by some of the most prestigious musical organisations in Britain. *True Light* reveals the energy and majestic sound world that he commands, as well as qualities of reflective intimacy. His *Missa Brevis* was inspired by seeing a beam of sunlight pierce a cloud of moving incense, the resultant music being built around a sustained pitch, ebbing and flowing. 

Siegfried Wagner's eight opera, Sonnenflammen ('Sun Flames'), portrays a deserter stranded in the decaying Byzantine Empire at the time of the Fourth Crusade. The tragedy reflects the mood in Germany at the time of the opera's creation in 1912, just before the outbreak of the First World War.
