



Claudio MONTEVERDI (1567–1643) **Complete Madrigals**

Delitiæ Musicæ · Marco Longhini

The madrigal, written for courts and patrons, was the ultimate secular song. The genre reached its zenith with the works of Claudio Monteverdi in successive books that trace his technical and expressive innovations. In them, Monteverdi explored themes such as the vicissitudes and pleasures of love, as well as the art of war, and the pain of loss. The editions used in these recordings are the most authentic and uncut, and, in keeping with 17th-century practice, employ male voices only. Praised as 'compelling, simultaneously controlled and imaginative' (American Record Guide) the collection also includes pieces never before recorded.

About Delitiæ Musicæ

The instrumental and vocal ensemble Delitiæ Musicæ is considered one of the most enterprising Italian early music ensembles, with important recordings in the last 20 years that include the Missa Philomena Praevia of Verdelot, four widely acclaimed albums dedicated to Masses of Palestrina based on the compositions of the Flemish composer Cipriano de Rore, Lupus and Jacquet de Mantua. The unconventional yet impassioned interpretations by Delitiæ Musicæ and Marco Longhini are seen as an important regeneration of Italian Renaissance and Baroque music.



Adolphe Adam's Le Postillon de Lonjumeau was a great success at its premiere in 1836, and, along with the ballet Giselle, has remained one of the composer's most popular works. Following the great French tradition, this opéra-comique has it all: 18th-century Rococo Parisian glamour and a perilous love story involving the dashing and flirtatious Chapelou and his opposite, the powerful and clever Madeleine. This lavish and spectacular production from the Opéra Comique in Paris received widespread critical acclaim and also features costumes by the iconic French fashion designer Christian Lacroix.



Key Features:

- Naxos had success with stage works by Adolphe Adam in the past, including the ballet Le Corsaire (2.110594 / NBD0090V) summed up as 'a hugely enjoyable romp' by MusicWeb International, and the music of the even more famous ballet Giselle (8.550755-56) given three stars by The Penguin Guide.
- A co-production by Opéra Comique with Opéra de Rouen Normandie, this 2019 performance was well received by critics, Classical Voice North America providing an extensive review: 'Differentiating between action contemplation, Michel Fau mounted large ensembles using the full stage, with arias and



The production featured a notable cast. Classical Voice North American wrote of the soloists: 'Franck Leguérinel's consummate performance as a comic singer-actor, pop-eyed and mustachioed like Groucho Mark, leading the action forward throughout the evening, was outstanding. Rossini's Neapolitan theatrical debut in 1815 won him overnight esteem as well as the favour of the Bourbon dynasty, ensuring lucrative contracts and commissions. The following year he composed Le nozze di Teti e di Peleo, an allegorical cantata on the theme of the wedding between the sea goddess Thetis and the hero Peleus. Written to celebrate a royal marriage, it is an intensely theatrical work in which Rossini drew on some of the greatest contemporary singers, specialists in the ornamented bel canto style, and created a staged spectacular with chorus and a wealth of colourful orchestration.

About the Artists

The Górecki Chamber Choir was founded in 2013 by the Passionart Society in connection with the first performance of church music by Henryk Górecki. In subsequent years the choir has given concerts of sacred music throughout Poland, under the direction of, among others, José Cura and Daniel Smith. The choir made its debut at Rossini in Wildbad in 2017.

The Virtuosi Brunensis chamber orchestra was established in 2007. The orchestra has appeared, among other engagements, at Rossini in Wildbad where it has recorded Rossini's Otello, L'Italiana in Algeri, Semiramide and Guillaume Tell, Vaccaj's La sposa di Messina and Mercadante's I briganti for Naxos, among others.

This performance, recorded live from the 2018 Rossini in Wildbad Festival, was received enthusiastic response from Opera News: The admirable Mert Süngu was an excellent Peleus. [His] musicality and superb technique were beyond criticism.' The chorus parts 'were attractively sung by the Górecki Chamber Choir.



The pointed, stylish playing of the Virtuosi Brunensis under the baton of Pietro Rizzo, was another pleasure in the presentation of this slender work.

The magazine added: 'Leonor Bonilla, as the goddess Ceres, was clearly an audience favorite. A warm, lyric soprano with an athletic technique, she mastered the difficulties of her aria with aplomb. However, the most beautiful voice of





the evening belonged to the American tenor Joshua Stewart, who brought an appropriate gravity of tone to the role of Zeus.

Soprano Eleonora Bellocci was First Prize winner at the International Competitions and 'Giulio Neri', and Guasco' is a recipient of the International Belcanto Prize at the Rossini in Wildbad festival. A winner of many prestigious competitions, mezzo-





soprano Marina Comparato has appeared on the Naxos release of Rossini's Zelmira (8.660468-70) from Rossini in Wildbad.

Daniel-François-Esprit AUBER (1782–1871) Overtures, Vol. 2

The second volume in this series (Volume 1 is on 8.574005) continues to explore little-known examples of Auber's elegant and refined operatic music. Julie was his first stage work, its fantasialike beauty foreshadowing the operas, opéras-comiques and lyric dramas to come. Striking melodies and haunting episodes abound in these overtures and entr'actes, and there is restrained yet fragrant Iberian colour in the overture to Léocadie. The Violin Concerto is lightly scored and gentle, with a tarantella-like finale full of folk vitality.

Key Features:

- Daniel-François-Esprit Auber was a leading composer of French opera from the 1820s onwards and was enormously popular in his day, but aside from the hit opera Fra Diavolo there are few recordings of his music currently available, and most of the overtures and incidental music recorded here are world premieres performed from archive sources.
- Vol. 1 in the series was released on December 2019 (8.574005). According to ClassicsToday.com, the 'release deserves attention on account of the repertoire's rarity', while Pizzicato wrote that Dario Salvi 'has a good instinct for this music, which blossoms brilliantly and richly under his hands.' (★★★★)
- Salvi specializes in the restoration and performance of rare works, the most recent of which is the world premiere recording of Johann Strauss II's operetta Blindekuh (8.660434-35). Operetta Research Center commented: 'Salvi colours his orchestra with the bright or tender nuances of Johann Strauss II, and leads his singers with the abandonment and love that animate his deep belief in this evocative and seductive music: a real happiness for the listener.





Christopher ROUSE (1949–2019) Symphony No. 5 **Supplica Concerto for Orchestra**

Few contemporary artists have been as significant as Pulitzer Prize and GRAMMY Award winner Christopher Rouse, whose imaginative approach made him one of the most frequently performed composers during his lifetime. The Concerto for Orchestra is a 'hyper-concerto' that gives each player a chance to shine, while the mournful intimacy and passion of Supplica unfolds somewhat like the slow movement of a Bruckner or Mahler symphony. Rouse's Fifth Symphony fondly recalls Beethoven's mighty Fifth but blurs the lines between tradition and modernity, transporting the listener from turbulence to serenity. It was described as "brilliant, exciting and at times hauntingly beautiful" in The Dallas Morning News.

About Giancarlo Guerrero

Six-time GRAMMY Award-winning conductor Giancarlo Guerrero is music director of the Nashville Symphony and the NFM Wrocław Philharmonic in Poland, as well as principal guest conductor of the Gulbenkian Orchestra in Lisbon, Portugal. He has championed contemporary American music through numerous commissions, recordings and performances with the Nashville Symphony, presenting eleven world premieres of works by Jonathan Leshnoff, Michael Daugherty, Terry Riley, and others. As part of this commitment, he helped guide the creation of Nashville Symphony's Composer Lab & Workshop initiative.

Key Features:

- Christopher Rouse's music achieved immense popularity during his lifetime, and his aim of trying 'to be of use: to sing you a song, to paint you a picture, to tell you a story' has resonated with audiences all over the world. The Pulitzer Prize and GRAMMYwinning composer passed in September 2019 at the age of 70.
- The GRAMMY nominated Seeing (8.559799) was summed up as 'magnificent' in the American Record Guide, and Wolf Rounds (8.572439) 'a virtuosic thrill-ride, to be sure – gripping, convincing, and a significant addition to the ever-growing literature for wind bands.' (MusicWeb International)
- Champions of new American music, the Nashville Symphony and its music director Giancarlo Guerrero had premiered numerous works, and received 13 GRAMMY Awards including two for Best Orchestral Performance. Among their award-winning recordings include works by Michael Daugherty (Metropolis Symphony on 8.559635; Tales of Hemingway on 8.559798), Stephen Paulus (Three Places of Enlightenment on 8.559740), and Jennifer Higdon (All Things Majestic and Viola Concerto on 8.559823).

About Barthold Kuijken

Barthold Kuijken is an eminent leader in the field of early music. A virtuoso traverso soloist, teacher and conductor, he has shaped the fields of historical flutes and historically informed performance over the last 40 years. Kuijken has widely performed and recorded the repertoire for the Baroque flute and has collaborated with other early music specialists including his brothers, Sigiswald Kuijken and Wieland Kuijken, Frans Brüggen, Gustav Leonhardt and Paul Dombrecht.

The Colourful Telemann presents works from different periods of Georg Philipp Telemann's life, reflecting his lively personality and exploring his seemingly unlimited invention over a wide variety of styles and genres. A contemporary of Bach and Handel, Telemann wrote music that stands out for its delightful and remarkably generous character, each piece like a leisurely walk with a good friend. From the German and French influences of the earlier Sonata to the dignified Sinfonia Melodica, possibly composed in the year of his death, this is Telemann at his best.

Key Features:

- This is the fourth recording the Indianapolis Baroque Orchestra for Naxos, with its artistic director renowned Baroque musician Barthold Kuijken. Also including a concerto by Telemann, their album The Grand Mogul (8.573899) was admired by the American Record Guide with remarks such as, 'Barthold Kuijken is one of the greatest Baroque flutists of our time, and his playing here is splendid.'
- Further albums from these musicians are The Lully Effect (8.573867), considered 'an unalloyed delight' in ConcertoNet.com, and The Versailles Revolution (8.573868) which 'breathes the spirit of the French court and, with the influence of Lully clearly at work throughout... Very fine performances and recording make it all the more desirable' for MusicWeb International.
- Named one of the top 25 ensembles in celebration of Early Music America's 25th anniversary in 2011, the Indianapolis Baroque Orchestra is dedicated to excellent and exuberant performance of 17th- and 18th-century music on period instruments. Praised for its performances of the French Baroque and beyond, members of the orchestra are some of the finest Baroque specialists in North America.

The six *Cello Suites* represent J.S. Bach's genius at its most distilled, with the composer confronting the enigma of writing counterpoint for a monophonic instrument at its core. Jeffrey McFadden's arrangement for guitar enhances the music, adding a harmonic dimension and making the implied interaction of voices explicit. The *Suites* contain some of the most fascinating and beautiful movements in all of Bach's *oeuvre*, and remain one of the most important works in the history of Western music. 'Jeffrey McFadden not only is an extraordinary guitarist – he's also an inspired musician' (*ClassicsToday.com* on Naxos 8.554354, works by Napoléon Coste).

About Jeffrey McFadden

Jeffrey McFadden has been acknowledged as one of the finest guitarists of his generation, with concert engagements taking him throughout Canada and the United States and into Europe. He has given world premieres of works by numerous composers and has been a featured performer at several international music festivals. His Naxos recordings include the music of Agustin Barrios, Napoléon Coste and Fernando Sor, and guitar duets by Mauro Giuliani recorded with Norbert Kraft.

Key Features:

- Bach's six Cello Suites have been arranged for guitar in the
 past, with Francisco Tárrega starting this tradition in the 19th
 century, followed by the likes of Andrés Segovia and John W.
 Duarte. Each new arrangement brings contemporary thinking
 and fresh insights and research, and Jeffrey McFadden's superb
 transcriptions have been applauded at numerous concert
 performances in which he was able to refine and hone his
 approach in advance of these recordings.
- McFadden recorded two instalments of Coste's guitar works for Naxos (Vol. 1 on 8.554192). Vol. 4 (8.554354) received a 10/10 score from ClassicsToday.com: 'Bass lines simply soar, and the bell-like sound he gets from the higher strings and remarkable registral independence makes us wonder if McFadden is actually playing a piano disguised as a guitar! No question, this is one of the loveliest discs in Naxos' burgeoning guitar collection.' His recording of American works for flute and guitar (8.559146), with flutist Alexandra Hawley, was similarly received with great acclaim by ClassicsToday.com (10/10).

Rodrigo's *Concierto de Aranjuez* is the most celebrated classical guitar work of the 20th century, music that conjures up the colour, sophistication and glories of eternal Spain. The founding father of Mexican music, Manuel Ponce, wrote his *Concierto del sur* for Segovia, and it is a work of vivid grandeur, Sevillian dances and melodic richness. To complete the programme, prize-winning international virtuoso Junhong Kuang plays a piece dedicated to him – Gerald Garcia's *China Sings!* – a rhapsody inspired by two popular Chinese tunes.

About Darrell Ang

Darrell Ang is the artistic director and chief conductor of China's Sichuan Symphony since December 2016. He regularly conducts the Radio France Philharmonic Orchestra, Royal Liverpool Philharmonic, Philharmonia Orchestra, London Philharmonic Orchestra, 'Giuseppe Verdi' Symphony Orchestra, Munich Radio Orchestra, NHK Symphony Orchestra, Queensland Symphony Orchestra, National Taiwan Symphony Orchestra, Singapore Symphony and at the Mariinsky Theatre in St Petersburg. Darrell Ang received a GRAMMY Award nomination for his Naxos debut recording of *Symphony 'Humen 1839'* by Zhou Long and Chen Yi (8.570611). His most recent albums feature Kabalevsky's First and Second Symphonies (8.573859) and d'Indy's incidental music *Médée* (8.573858), among others.

Key Features:

- Born in 1999 in China, Junhong Kuang was awarded the top prize in the classical guitar category of the prestigious ARD Music Competition in 2017, along with the Audience Prize and the ifp-Musikpreis, becoming the youngest prizewinner in the ARD's history. Kuang made his recording debut with an album of music by Bach, Albéniz, Granados, Barrios Mangoré and Mertz, released on Naxos in 2015 to great critical acclaim (8.573432).
- While Rodrigo's concerto is one of the popular pieces in the repertoire, this release's highlight is the world premiere recording of Gerald Garcia's *China Sings!*, in its 2019 version for guitar and orchestra, which was dedicated for Junhong Kuang. Also included is a rare recording of Ponce's *Concierto del sur*.
- The Czech Chamber Philharmonic Orchestra Pardubice is regarded as one of the world's leading representatives of Czech musical culture, and has recorded extensively for various labels. Their numerous Naxos albums include symphonies by Leopold Koželuch and Michael Haydn as well as overtures by Domenico Cimarosa, among others.



French-Argentinian composer Esteban Benzecry has built up a distinctive body of work, from symphonies to works for solo piano. He stands as a worthy successor to such masters as Ginastera, Villa-Lobos and Chávez, with music that is suffused with 'imaginary folklore', flashes of colour, fieriness and reverie. The autobiographical Violin Concerto draws on South American folk motifs and rhythms, whereas in Ciclo de canciones he explores the meeting of two cultures, Argentinian and Japanese. The breathtaking dialogues between soloist and orchestra in the Clarinet Concerto recall Andean and pre-Hispanic times.

Key Features:

Esteban Benzecry is one of the most performed and commissioned Argentinian composers of his generation. His most recent works attempt to fuse Latin American-inspired rhythms with the diverse aesthetics of European contemporary music to create a personal language and an imaginary folklore. This release celebrates his 50th birthday last April 2020.



Japanese coloratura soprano Ayako Tanaka made her debut in Le nozze di Figaro at the Stadttheater Bern at the age of 22 - the youngest soloist to appear at the theatre. She gave the world premiere of Esteban Benzecry's award-winning Ciclo de canciones in 2017 with the Argentine National Symphony Orchestra in Buenos Aires, a work inspired by Tanaka's voice. In 2019 was selected as one of '100 Japanese People the World Respects' by Newsweek Japan.



A winner of numerous international competitions, Pablo Boggiano regularly works with the Orquesta Sinfónica Nacional and Orquesta Filarmónica de Buenos Aires del Teatro Colón in Argentina, among others. In 2017 he was invited by Teatro Colón to work on an international production of Richard Strauss's Der Rosenkavalier.







One of the least explored areas of Beethoven's compositions is the miscellaneous sequence of canons, early exercises in counterpoint, mature jokes and jeux d'esprit that he wrote over many years. He also wrote birthday and Christmas greetings for colleagues and friends, and songs that punned on recipients' names or poked fun at them.

Ferdinand Rebay was born in Vienna where he studied piano and composition, winning the Brahms Prize. He wrote operas, a symphony, concertos and many songs, but was increasingly drawn to writing for the guitar for which he wrote 600 pieces of various kinds. The three sonatas recorded here are little known and reflect Rebay's immersion in Romantic neo-Classicism. Themes are lyrical, utilising folk song, energetic March themes and variations, with a tapestry of emotions both sombre and exuberant.

Key Features:

Laurence Kayaleh has recorded the complete works for violin and piano by Medtner, Honegger and Catoire for Naxos. Pampered while Lisbeth works in the fields, Adeline makes an enviable leap in status when Baron Hulot offers her his hand in marriage. Out of kindness, they bring Lisbeth to Paris, where she falls in love with the artist Wenceslas, her protégé. However, when she is jilted for Adeline's daughter Hortense, her jealousy and rage exponentially intensify, and she resolves to bring the Hulot family to ruin, employing the cold seductress Valérie Marneffe as her vehicle for revenge. A classic tale of obsession, self-destruction and unabated desire, Cousin Bette is a blazing portrayal of libertine France, and the fatal excesses which drive the novel to its dark end.
