Erich Wolfgang Korngold was at the height of his fame and technical mastery by the time he began work on his fourth opera in 1923. Prominent opera houses clamoured to stage his works, and the Viennese premiere of Das Wunder der Heliane ('The Miracle of Heliane') featured Lotte Lehmann among its star cast. Its story is one of the redemptive power of love over injustice and adversity, expressed in music that is richly impressionistic and intensely dramatic. Korngold was criticised for resisting the tide of modernist atonality in this opulent score, but its symbolism and compelling romantic atmosphere can be appreciated today more than ever.

Key Features:

- Korngold's music was largely forgotten after his death but has more recently become recognized as a key element in early 20th century artistic endeavor. By comparison with the Violin Concerto and his previous opera Die tote Stadt, Korngold's fourth opera Das Wunder der Heliane (The Miracle of Heliane) has rarely been performed.
- With such a fine recording of a rarity on stage or CD, we are confident that this release of Das Wunder der Heliane will be widely appreciated, and provide yet another milestone in Korngold's revival as a significant figure in Western musical heritage.
- This Freiburg Opera production of Das Wunder der Heliane has a strong cast topped by soprano Annemarie Kremer (Heliane), one of the most successful singers in the lyric dramatic soprano repertoire. Award-winning





baritone Aris Argiris (The Ruler) has established an international career, performing regularly at the world's most prestigious opera houses.

About Fabrice Bollon

Fabrice Bollon studied with Michael Gielen and Nikolaus Harnoncourt in Paris and at Salzburg's Mozarteum before completing his studies with Georges Prêtre and Mauricio Kagel. From 2009 he has been general music director/chief conductor at Germany's Theater Freiburg. In September 2016 Bollon was unanimously re-elected for another term and began recording for Naxos. His work in Freiburg has received international acclaim including the UK performances of Parsifal and Tannhäuser, as well as Gramophone Editor's Choice and Diapason d'or Awards, among others. Fabrice Bollon is also an acclaimed composer: his opera Oscar und die Dame in Rosa was highly acclaimed by both critics and audiences.

- This recording follows the April 2018 release of Bach's St John Passion (8.573817-18) with the Bach Choir & Orchestra of Mainz conducted by Ralf Otto. MusicWeb International highlights the choir in its review, "the Bachchor Mainz is a fine ensemble: it shows great flexibility in those turbae which are performed at a high speed, and produces a surprisingly transparent sound, also thanks to the good acoustic of the Christuskirche in Mainz." A reviewer for Pizzicato commented that "Ralf Otto, his ensemble and his soloists give a very dramatic, almost operatic account of Bach's St John Passion."
- As with the St John Passion the cast for this production is led by Georg Poplutz as the Evangelist, a role for which he has already received acclaim: "this slim tenor who impressively expressed the words of the Evangelist, but was also convincing in arias delivered with great dynamic breadth and color." Further soloists are the alto **Katharina Magiera**, a leading member of the Frankfurt Opera who has appeared in many of the major European opera houses, and **Thomas E**. **Bauer**, a bass very much

• The Bachchor and Bachorchester Mainz are, as their name suggests, immersed in the music of Bach. Ralf Otto has established an intensive exploration of historical performance practices affirming the choir's unique profile. Bachchor Mainz has released numerous recordings, has broadcast widely, and frequent performances with guest conductors such as Riccardo Chailly, Sylvain Cambreling, Michael Gielen, Eliahu Inbal, Georges Prêtre and Franz Welser-Möst is symbolic of the choir's outstanding quality.

J.S. Bach's *Christmas Oratorio* was written for the Christmas season of 1734, and although it incorporates music from earlier works it belongs firmly among his timeless large-scale compositions. The development of the oratorio, which was to become a new musical form in Protestant church services at that time, was stimulated by Bach's compositions, particularly by the unusual form of his sixpart *Christmas Oratorio*. From its famously joyful opening '*Jauchzet frohlocket*' to the arrival of the Wise Men from the East, this work's enduring popularity has long proven its status as a choral 'evergreen'.

About Ralf Otto

For the conductor Ralf Otto, flexibility, diversity and transparency of sound have always been essential to his work with choirs and orchestras. The conductor's reputation is based on his gift for interpreting different musical styles, from the Renaissance through to the music of today. Since the beginning of his career, he has been a strong advocate for the performance of early music according to historically informed performance practices. Otto's repertoire encompasses Monteverdi, the complete works of Bach, essential works from the Baroque period, the Viennese classics, the Romantic period, Britten, Eisler, Dallapiccola, Schoenberg and contemporary composers. His numerous recordings and broadcasts are a testament to his artistic achievements.

Adapted from Thomas Mann's 1912 novella. Death in Venice was Benjamin Britten's last opera, the composer insisting on its completion while delaying badly needed heart surgery. The starkly simple narrative of a famous but failing novelist travelling to Venice to seek inspiration only to find unhealthy infatuation and deadly cholera, is given a chamber-like precision and clarity through Britten's score, becoming a haunting drama filled with musical symbols, disquieting mystery and richly evocative atmospheres of Venice and its strange characters. Willy Decker's Teatro Real production was described as 'one of his most brilliant stage works... a remarkable technical feat.' (bachtrack.com)

- There are a handful of audiovisual recordings of Britten's Death in Venice, and the vibrantly inventive and breathtakingly imaginative quality of Willy Decker's Teatro Real production can easily compete with and even surpass the competition.
- bachtrack.com reviewer Fernando Remiro described this production as "a remarkable technical feat, with smooth and dynamic transitions and a great sense of rhythm, and goes beyond the mere illustration of the plot, showing a deep understanding of the story. The result is a visually enticing show, full of powerful images and symbols that evolve organically as the drama unfolds..." Remiro also admired John Daszak in the principal role: "Aschenbach is one of the most difficult roles Britten wrote for Pears, always on stage and bearing all the weight of the drama. He moved comfortably along the vocal range and had some beautiful moments..

Commissioned in 1846, *Macbeth* offered *Verdi* the opportunity to make a qualitative leap in his career and its premiere was triumphantly received by audiences. Yet the libretto had proved problematic and many Italian critics did not share the composer's reverence for Shakespeare. Verdi surmounted all concerns with an opera that valued brevity but also preserved the play's most important elements. The formidable final *concertato* stands as one of his greatest achievements thus far, his pacing and detailing of the opera as a whole far surpassing his previous works. This production preserves the preferred 1865 revision of the work, sung in Italian and retaining the original 1847 finale.


he has sung at all the leading European opera houses for the best-known conductors.



JoAnn Falletta serves as music director of the Buffalo Philharmonic and Virginia Symphony and is the principal guest conductor of the Brevard Music Center of North Carolina. She has guest conducted over a hundred orchestras in North America, and many of the most prominent orchestras in Europe, Asia, South America and Africa. Recipient of the Seaver/National Endowment for the Arts Conductors Award, winner of the Stokowski Competition, and the Toscanini, Ditson and Bruno Walter conducting awards, Falletta became the first female conductor to lead a major American ensemble upon her appointment as music director of the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra in 1999. She has received twelve ASCAP awards, served on the U.S. National Council on the Arts, and is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

Franz Schreker was a prominent figure in early 20th-century Austro-German music, his reputation as an opera composer rivalling that of Richard Strauss. The *Prelude to a Drama* is the concert overture of Schreker's acclaimed opera *Die Gezeichneten*, a lurid drama involving murder and madness. Conceived as a theatrical pantomime, *The Birthday of the Infanta* adapts Oscar Wilde's tragic tale of an ugly dwarf who dies of a broken heart, while the *Romantic Suite* fully explores the composer's colourfully detailed and translucent orchestration and lyrical expressiveness.

Key Features:

- Franz Schreker is best known as an operatic composer, but his stylistic plurality also shines through in the orchestral works collected here: from the Expressionist Vorspiel zu einem Drama to the popular Romantische Suite, a piece that wears its highly emotive nature in its title. With the more Classical descriptiveness of Der Geburtsdag der Infantin this program is perfectly balanced and forms an excellent introduction to a composer whose approachable idiom often comes as a pleasant surprise to those unfamiliar with his work.
- Previous Naxos releases of Franz Schreker's works include his opera Der Ferne Klang (8.660074-75), "strongly recommended" by The Penguin Guide, and a collection of Overtures (8.555246) considered "irresistible" by ClassicsToday.com.
- Conductor JoAnn Falletta's recordings for Naxos include the double GRAMMY® Award-winning disc of Mr. Tambourine Man by John Corigliano (8.559331) considered "first rate" by the Charlestown Gazette, and several further GRAMMY® Award-nominated discs of works by Dohnányi, Fuchs, Gershwin, Hailstork, Holst, Respighi, Schubert, Strauss, and Tyberg.
- The Berlin Radio Symphony Orchestra dates back to the beginnings of music broadcasting in 1923. Since then it has developed its position to become one of Berlin's top orchestras, and today is ranked in the highest echelon of German radio orchestras.



Pulitzer Prize-winner and MacArthur fellow John Harbison has composed a Requiem for our times - a moving choral work that incorporates the composer's distinctive sensibilities while drawing deeply on the tradition of Latin sacred music. Completed in the wake of the 9/11 attacks, Harbison's Requiem is full of dramatic passages from singers and musicians alike, with abundant opportunities for vocal soloists, brass and percussion to shine. "I wanted my piece to have a sense of the inexorability of the passage of time," the composer says, "for good and ill, of the commonality of love and loss."

About Giancarlo Guerrero

Giancarlo Guerrero is the six-time GRAMMY®-winning music director of the Nashville Symphony, music director of the Wrocław Philharmonic in Poland, and principal guest conductor of the Gulbenkian Orchestra in Lisbon, Portugal. A passionate proponent of new music, he has championed a number of America's most respected composers through recordings, commissions, and eight world premieres with the Nashville Symphony, including the GRAMMY®-winning recording of Michael Daugherty's Tales of Hemingway. Recent seasons have seen performances dedicated to the music of Terry Riley, Richard Danielpour, and Jennifer Higdon.

Marin Alsop is an inspiring and powerful voice in the international music scene who passionately believes that "music has the power to change lives." She became music director of the São Paulo Symphony Orchestra in 2012 and made history in 2013 as the first female conductor of the BBC's Last Night of the Proms, which she returned to conduct in 2015. As a student of Leonard Bernstein, Alsop is central to his 100th anniversary celebrations, conducting Bernstein's *Mass* at the Ravinia Festival, where she serves as musical curator for 2018 and 2019.

This recording brings together music from some of Leonard Bernstein's best-loved scores with seldom heard occasional works and premiere recordings. From the iconic musical West Side Story, the hot-blooded dance number Mambo embodies the show's dramatic tensions. Slava! celebrates Bernstein's friend and colleague, the cellist and conductor Mstislav Rostropovich, in music reworked from the daring show 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, from which the Suite rescues further highlights. CBS Music has not been heard since the broadcasting giant's 50th anniversary celebrations in 1978, while the Birthday Bouquet takes the form of affectionate musical tributes from eight composer colleagues to one of the 20th century's greatest musicians.







Septura head homeward, with a recording of British music from the first half of the 20th century – a golden age in England's otherwise chequered compositional history, and a period in which brass instruments, in the form of the brass band, established their place at the very heart of British musical culture. Alfred BRUNEAU (1857–1934) L'Attaque du moulin – Suite

A composition pupil of Jules Massenet, Alfred Bruneau was largely responsible for introducing realism into French opera. His friendship with the writer Émile Zola, who shared his desire for theatrical naturalism, strongly informed his work, not least *L'Attaque du moulin* ('The Attack on the Mill'), a 'drame lyrique'. The suite includes rustic elements, but also Mascagni-like verismo beauty tempered by a Gallic palette. Bruneau was a deft orchestrator with a taste for exotic colour, and the excerpts from *Messidor* show the influence of Wagner on one of the most important but overlooked figures in turn-of-the-century French musical life.

Key Features:

- A Marco Polo release in 1994 has the same repertoire as this new recording from the Barcelona Symphony and Darrell Ang. That disc is no longer available, so this new album is a perfect opportunity to re-introduce the Alfred Bruneau's works.
- Darrell Ang's discography on Naxos includes several recordings of French orchestral music. The most recent is a collection of overtures by Jacques Offenbach with the Orchestre National de Lille (8.573694). It received a MusicWeb International Recording of the Month award, and also an AllMusic.com Editor's Choice.



Ang and the Barcelona Symphony Orchestra also accompanied Tianwa Yang in a disc of Lalo's Symphonie espagnole and Manén's Concierto español (8.573067). The orchestra also recorded Bizet's Carmen and L'Arlésienne Suites in which American Record Guide wrote: "the interpretations are superb, the orchestra finely balanced."





Alexander Moyzes was one of the most significant figures in modern Slovak music, synthesising the national musical style inherited from his teacher Vítězslav Novák with wider European contemporary trends. Both of these symphonies were written in a happy period of the composer's life – before his musical oeuvre was overshadowed by conflict. The eloquent and sprightly *Fifth Symphony* is a celebration of 'the heritage of my dear father', who was also a talented musician and an important figure in Alexander's development as a composer. The *Sixth Symphony* is notable for its clarity and symmetry, from the simple theme of its opening to the brilliant contrapuntal *fugato* in its closing movement.

Key Features:

- Alexander Moyzes is probably best known for his symphonies, this is Vol. 3 in a series
 of re-issues from the Marco Polo label. These releases remain as the only easily
 accessible reference, and with recordings and performances that still sound fresh and
 invigorating we felt it was time for a revival.
- Of the original release, MusicWeb International commented: "There are definite folk inflections, all incisively propelled by the late Ladislav Slovák and his orchestra who presumably know these symphonies better than anyone."
- Conductor **Ladislav Slovák** was a long-time director of the Slovák Philharmonic, taking over the post from Václav Talich. Alongside Moyzes he recorded the complete symphonies of Shostakovich for Naxos with this orchestra. These were acclaimed in their day by *Classic CD* as "excellently gripping performances", and *DB Magazine* declaring "one to seriously rival the ruling Rozhdestvensky and Haitink versions" while commenting on Symphonies Nos. 2 and 15 (8.550624).

A follow-up to Latino Ladino (8.573566), which focuses on music of the Sephardic diaspora after the 1492 expulsion of Jews and Muslims from Spain, the programme for Exaltation is drawn from Medieval and Baroque Europe, Turkey and the Near East, and includes beautiful examples of the Sephardic and Sufi traditions. This essentially joyful album, which combines instruments from different cultures and ages to include distinctive timbres such as the didgeridoo, ney flute, flamenco guitar and more, topped by Yaniv d'Or's haunting countertenor voice, celebrates the spirit that binds the wandering communities, the gods they worship and the hopes they share for a harmonious co-existence.

Key Features:

The unique countertenor voice of Yaniv d'Or has confirmed his status as one of the stars of the modern international music scene. Exaltation follows Yaniv d'Or and Ensemble NAYA's album Latino Ladino (8.573566) released in July 2016. Critical acclaim for this recording included comment from The Huffington Post: "Extraordinary stuff here, achingly personal and exquisitely lyrical... what makes these ancient reflections on beauty, love, joy and sorrow so profoundly expressive of basic human feelings and



needs is Yaniv d'Or's haunting, vulnerable countertenor, backed by a folkish Baroque instrumental backdrop that suggests a Fellini fantasy." Yaniv d'Or was complimented by Gramophone for "his rich, honeyed falsetto", and Fanfare admiring Ensemble NAYA's "perfect foundation for d'Or's clear and highly nuanced voice. - Yaniv d'Or has also recorded Schumann, Debussy and others in his *Thoughts Observed* recital (8.573780) released in June 2017. This was an Opera News Critic's Choice and admired by them as a "performance of considerable dynamism and penetration".



Famed for his sequence of Piano Concertos, Sterndale Bennett also wrote a small but distinguished body of chamber music. The String Quartet in G major is one of his earliest surviving works, revealing a precocious talent still strongly influenced by Haydn. Mendelssohn is the model for the Sextet, though Bennett's highly virtuosic piano writing, with its concertante interplay, reinforces the work's lyrical qualities and required dexterity as well as its advanced harmonies and hymnal beauty. The concise Chamber Trio radiates sheer charm while displaying an even greater grasp of structure and is the first English example in the trio form where both string instruments are given parts independent of the piano.

Key Features:

The Villiers Quartet are British chamber music specialists; their 2017 recording of the Delius and Elgar Quartets (8.573586) was very well reviewed. MusicWeb International wrote: "This is a desirable chamber release with convincing and stylish playing from the Villiers Quartet who offer endearing expression and impeccable intonation throughout."



- The quartet's recording of Fricker Quartets (8.571374) is 'Recommended' by The Strad: "This is demanding music, and the Villiers Quartet has done well for reviving it with such immersive mastery that the occasionally grey, cardboard quality of the melodic material is coloured and corrugated into quirky, restlessly compelling structures.

Ferdinand Ries grew up in the same musical environment that nurtured Beethoven, both counting Ferdinand's father Franz as one of their teachers and the two of them becoming the closest of friends. Ries was a gifted and prolific composer in every instrumental genre. His Violin Sonatas are based on the Viennese Classical style established by Mozart but with a freshness and originality that includes movements such as the Adagio of the Sonata, Op. 38, No. 3, one of Ries's loveliest creations. The Sonatas Op. 38, Nos. 1 & 2 can be heard on the 2nd volume of this edition (8.573717), 'unreservedly recommended' by Fanfare magazine.

Key Features:

- The combination of flute and harp always creates an atmosphere of beauty, with contrasting but complementary sonorities that have been exploited by a multitude of composers over the years. The pastoral theme of this program has been carefully chosen to include music from the Baroque and Romantic eras right up to the contemporary, including Paul Reade's much-loved Ivor Novello award-winning TV theme for the BBC's The Victorian Kitchen Garden, and John Marson's fun finale, Strawberries and Cream.
- One of Canada's foremost flautists, Suzanne Shulman has earned international critical acclaim for solo recitals in renowned venues such as Carnegie Hall, the Wigmore Hall in London and the Chopin Institute in Warsaw. Andreas Hakenberger spent his entire professional career within the territory of the Crown of the Kingdom of Poland, remaining for 20 years as chapel-master at the lutheran Church of St Mary's in Gdańsk. Here he wrote his most outstanding works, a sequence of important motets written in cori spezzati, or polychoral technique. The rich tonal colouring obtained through the combinations of vocal parts is enhanced by the variety of the accompanying instrumentation. With astute use of imitation and rhetorical pauses, Hakenberger's music emerges as richly colourful, graceful and vibrant.

Key Features:

- There have been very few recordings of the music of the Polish composer Andreas Hakenberger. This release offers by far the most of his music yet to be issued, and contains all of the 55 Motets preserved in the Pelplin Tablature.
- The Polski Chór Kameralny specialises in variety, performing music from all genres and periods, including Gregorian chant, motets, opera, oratorio, film music, jazz, pop, and modern classical compositions. It has given 620 world premiere performances by composers including Henryk Mikołaj Górecki and Krzysztof Penderecki, and many more who have dedicated compositions to the choir.









It is perhaps the most personal of Trollope's Palliser series, being coloured by the author's own experiences as a Liberal candidate between the time he wrote this and *Phineas Finn*.
