






Peter Breiner is one of the world's most recorded musicians, with acclaimed releases such as *Beatles Go Baroque* (Naxos 8.555010), accounting for millions of albums sold. An exceptional composer/arranger and an accomplished pianist, Breiner is equally at home in almost every genre of music. His origins in Slovakia and his experience in composing for films and for all kinds of audiences has resulted in a personal style that is both accessible and deeply touching. The tranquil and serene pieces for *Caressing Your Soul* meld melodic substance with musical expression to provide solace, relief and peace of mind in an oasis of calming music.

About Peter Breiner

Peter Breiner is one of the world's most recorded musicians, with over 200 albums released and multiple streams and downloads. Known as a conductor, composer, pianist and arranger, he has conducted, often doubling as a pianist, the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, the Bournemouth, Jerusalem, New Zealand, Moscow and Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestras, the Hong Kong Philharmonic Orchestra, the Slovak Philharmonic and the Orchestre National de France, to mention just a few. His compositions and arrangements have been played in concerts and broadcast worldwide, and some of the most prestigious ballet companies have used his music in numerous performances.

This programme includes some piano versions of music from his recent orchestral album Slovak Dances, Naughty and Sad released in September 2020 (8.574184-85).




Peter Breiner is one of the world's most performed composer/arrangers, with a boundless musicality that has led him to create fusions of music from a variety of genres. Drawing on traditions established by Brahms and Dvořák and showcasing leading folk music soloists, his *Slovak Dances* are an exuberant and kaleidoscopic monument rooted in Slovak musical folklore. It comprises 16 symphonic fantasias on songs that evoke varying emotions with an autobiographical element that follows Breiner's life from his origins in Humenné and Košice to New York.



Choreographer Jiří Bubeníček's *Carmen* celebrates the incredible inspiration of Bizet's timeless music in a completely new two-act ballet that also includes music by Albéniz, Castelnuovo-Tedesco and Falla, orchestrated and adapted by Gabriele Bonolis. The production emphasises aspects of the original drama, heightening erotic atmosphere of the cigar factory and Carmen's wild spirit, and including a spectacular on-stage horse. - This new ballet version uses Bizet's inspired music but creates an entirely new two-hour ballet which follows the detail and narrative of Mérimée's original novella much more closely than the opera. The score draws not only on Bizet's music, but also uses pieces by Albéniz, Falla and Castelnuovo-Tedesco, as well as some music from Gabriele Bonolis, who orchestrated the new score and was a close collaborator with the choreographer Jiří Bubeníček.
- This is conductor Louis Lohraseb's professional debut as a conductor but is clearly a name to look out for in the future. He is rapidly becoming one of the most promising young conductors of his generation, and is currently a Domingo-Colburn-Stein Young Artist at LA Opera, where he is assistant to conductor James Conlon
- Gramilano admired the cast for this production: 'Amar Ramasar
 is impressively charismatic, a fine actor, and moves beautifully
 contrasting his noble line with more modern contortions, most
 notably during his Flower Song solo which Bubeníček has
 constructed with loving care.'
- Classical Music Daily also reviewed this production: 'Teatro dell'Opera's good orchestra was conducted with ability by Louis Lohraseb, who has, no doubt, a merit in making this world premiere vibrant and full of tension. Gianni Carluccio's sets are simple and effective: a single set integrated with painted drops and projections. Also, Anna Biagiotti's costumes are almost Spartan, but in line with the music and the sets... The evening was a triumph for this new Carmen.'

André MESSAGER (1853–1929) **Fortunio**

André Messager's Fortunio premiered in 1907 at the Opéra Comique, where it received acclaim that was to last decades. One of the last composers to devote his entire career to opera and operetta, Messager exemplified in his music a feeling for dramatic pacing and the spirit of Belle Époque, qualities that permeate Fortunio, a comédie lyrique in which the dialogue in the libretto is given a continuous musical setting. Taking Alfred de Musset's play Le Chandelier as his source, Messager explores upper-class society at the turn of the 19th century with subtlety of characterisation and a thoroughly French orchestral transparency.

- This 2019 **Opéra Comique** production of Messager's *Fortunio* is a celebration of the work's success when it was premiered by the same company in 1907. Bachtrack gave the performance 5 stars: 'To bring this really simple story to life, Denis Podalydès read the booklet literally. There is no salient dramaturgical proposition here... The direction is impeccable in precision and fluidity. It must be said that the singers are all excellent actors'.
- Online Merker praised the cast: 'The cast was led by Cyrille Dubois as Fortunio. [He] was perfect, from his restrained aria 'Je suis très tendre et très farouche' to his final admission of love 'Dieu! Je rêve! Etre aimé de vous!', in which he effortlessly came across the orchestra without losing his beautiful timbre. Anne-Catherine Gillet was on a par with him as a beloved, unreachable Jacqueline, as were Jean-Sébastien Bou as a smart womanizer Clavaroche and Franck Leguérinel as a very funny jealous husband Maître André.
- Bachtrack added: 'In the pit the Orchestre des Champs-Élysées surpasses itself. From his precise and attentive direction, Louis Langrée obtains the best from his musicians, to whom he infuses all the tenderness that this work inspires in him - the first opera he has conducted. Like a visual artist, the conductor works with an orchestral material that is as ductile as one wishes to lovingly sculpt musical landscapes as beautiful as they are varied, between unbridled gaiety and dramatic intensity. Finally, each of the interventions of Chœur Les Éléments is accurate and precise, both vocally and scenically.

Jules Massenet is famous for his series of 27 operas that include Manon and Werther, but he also wrote a significant portfolio of orchestral music which include ballets, orchestral suites and incidental music. The works presented here show his versatility and lyricism and include the one-act ballet Espada, saturated in Iberian colour and beguiling rhythms, as well as Les Érinnyes ('The Furies') with a vivid sequence of contrasting themes. Modelled after Liszt, Visions is a poème-symphonique of both ethereal and dramatic power.

Key Features:

- Jean-Luc Tingaud's recordings for Naxos have always done very well, with Poulenc's Les Biches (8.573739) given a 10/10 score by ClassicsToday.com, along with comments such as 'Tingaud's precise, clear-eyed direction is just what this music needs'. Vincent d'Indy's Second Symphony (8.573522), also with the RSNO, was given a rave review by Fanfare: 'This recording [by] Tingaud and his Scottish orchestra should absolutely fire up new interest in a composer who has been unjustly neglected. Very strongly, if not urgently, recommended.
- Their most recent recording of Franck's symphonic poem Psyché (8.573955) also received a 10/10 score from ClassicsToday.com and the 'Supersonic' award from Pizzicato: 'we are dealing with top-class performances here... Repertoire value and interpretation justify our top rating.
- The Royal Scottish National Orchestra has a worldwide reputation for the quality of its recordings, receiving two Diapason d'or de l'année awards for Symphonic Music and eight GRAMMY Award nominations over the last decade. The RSNO's numerous Naxos recordings include Roussel's Symphony No. 2 (8.570529) which gained the Gramophone 'Editor's Choice'

Jean-Luc Tingaud has conducted the Royal Philharmonic English Chamber Orchestra, Ulster Orchestra, Orchestra, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, Filarmonica Arturo Toscanini, the Warsaw and Kraków Philharmonics, Orchestre National des Pays de la Loire, Orchestre National de Lyon, Orchestre National de Lorraine and Tokyo Philharmonic Orchestra, among others. His recordings include Sapho (Wexford), Werther (Martina Franca), La Voix humaine (Compiègne) and Le Siège de Corinthe (Bad Wildbad) and, most recently for Naxos, works by Bizet, Dukas, Franck, d'Indy and Poulenc.


Richard Strauss was appointed co-director of the Vienna State Opera in 1919 and soon set about composing a new ballet for the refurbished historic Redoutensaal in the city. At carnival in February 1923 the work was unveiled – a delectable series of eight arrangements of music by François Couperin called *Tanzsuite*. For the *Divertimento*, an orchestral suite that includes characteristic Straussian orchestration, and which was written many years later, Strauss rearranged six movements from the earlier work and added two further dances.

About Jun Märkl

Jun Märkl is a highly respected interpreter of core Germanic repertoire and has become known for his refined and idiomatic explorations of the French Impressionists. His long-standing relationships with the state operas of Vienna, Berlin, Munich, Semperoper Dresden and the Metropolitan Opera have been complemented by his music directorships of the Orchestre National de Lyon and the MDR Leipzig Radio Symphony Orchestra. Among the more than 50 albums Märkl has recorded are the complete Schumann symphonies with the NHK Symphony Orchestra; Mendelssohn and Wagner with the MDR Leipzig Radio Symphony Orchestra; and a highly acclaimed Debussy series with the Orchestre National de Lyon. He is currently working on a cycle of works by Saint-Saëns, R. Strauss and Hosokawa.

Jun Märkl and the excellent MDR Leipzig Radio players...provide a lively selection.' (BBC Music Magazine)
- Of Märkl's Lortzing overtures album (8.573824), Fanfare wrote: 'Jun Märkl and his Swedish musicians do everything in their power to sell these works... The playing is flexible and sympathetic, and Naxos' engineering team captures the orchestra with atmosphere and realism.'
- The conductor is also celebrated for his 8-disc set of Debussy's complete orchestral works (8.509002), described as 'a fascinating and extensive collection' by the *International Record Review*. His other Naxos recordings feature the on-going cycles of orchestral music by Saint-Saëns and Toshio Hosokawa.
- The New Zealand Symphony Orchestra (NZSO) is New Zealand's national orchestra. In 2016, the NZSO was nominated for Best Orchestral Performance at the prestigious GRAMMY Awards for their recording of Zhou Long and Chen Yi's Symphony 'Humen 1839' (8.570611).




Bernard Herrmann was famous for his film scores, but he was also a leading figure in music for radio, to which he brought his inimitable palette of mood and sonority. Whitman, whose subject is Walt Whitman's collection of poems Leaves of Grass, was a 1944 radio drama, a genre now much neglected but revived in this newly restored version. Psycho: A Narrative for String Orchestra is not a suite or excerpts from the film but a concert work, re-ordered and re-composed, while Souvenirs de voyage is one of the most polished and seductive of all American chamber works.

Key Features:

- Everyone appreciates Herrmann for his singular achievements as a film composer. Without him, there would be no *Psycho*, *North by Northwest*, or *Vertigo*, and *Citizen Kane* would be a far lesser film. But Herrmann also produced a substantial catalogue of concert works in the same style. He was as well a great figure in the forgotten history of radio. This new album is headlined by the world premiere recording of the newly restored score to the radio play *Whitman*.
- The PostClassical Ensemble is well-known for their projects
 of restoring and re-recording full scores of classic films. The DVD
 release of Redes (2.110372), featuring the score by Silvestre
 Revueltas, gained positive remarks for their 'alert and passionate'
 performance and summed up as a 'powerful and unforgettable
 sequence' by Soundstage! Xperience.
- Praised by The New York Times as a 'sensitive and subtle singer' who is able to evoke 'the special character of every song that he sings,' William Sharp is a frequent guest of PostClassical Ensemble. He most recently appeared with in Native American Inspirations at the Washington National Cathedral a series of concerts that celebrated the songs, piano, choral, and chamber works by Arthur Farwell.
 - Murray Horwitz is a playwright and broadcaster who currently hosts *The Big Broadcast* on WAMU. He is the recipient of three Peabody Awards, and is the co-author of the Tony Award-winning Broadway musical, *Ain't Misbehavin'*.



Brahms' *Ein deutsches Requiem* was initially conceived as a 'cantata of grief' – it was the death of his mother and the desire to create a memorial to his friend Robert Schumann that makes this music so intensely personal. With its radiant messages of humanity, consolation and comfort, the *Requiem* caused a sensation and made Brahms famous virtually overnight. The work is heard here with its 'ad libitum' organ and contrabassoon reinstated, enormously intensifying the depth of tone colours and lower sonorities.

About Ralf Otto

Ralf Otto

For the conductor **Ralf Otto** flexibility, diversity and transparency of sound have always been essential for his work with orchestras and choirs. Otto believes that understanding the compositional structure of a piece of music is an indispensable prerequisite to achieving intensely emotional expression. The conductor's reputation is based on his gift for interpreting different musical styles, from the Renaissance to the music of today. Since the beginning of his career, he has been a strong advocate for the performance of early music according to historically informed performance practices. His numerous recordings and broadcasts are a testament to his artistic achievements.

- Austrian soprano Christina Gansch was the winner of the 2014 Ferrier Award, since when she has been in demand at opera houses all over Europe, and including a performance of Brahms' Ein deutsches Requiem with Kent Nagano in Hamburg. 2017–2018 marked Gansch's first season as a freelance artist, beginning with Sarvilla in the highly acclaimed production of La cle



Servilia in the highly acclaimed production of *La clemenza di Tito* at the Salzburg Festival with Teodor Currentzis and Peter Sellars.

Bass-baritone Matthias Winckhler was awarded the Trude Eipperle Rieger Advancement Prize in 2017, and he won First Prize in 2014 at the Salzburg International Mozart Competition, as well as the Mozarteum Foundation Special Prize. Concert appearances have seen him appear at renowned festivals including the Salzburg Eastival the Kissingen Summer Festival the Leir



Festival, the Kissingen Summer Festival, the Leipzig Bachfest, the Thuringian Bach Weeks, and the Salzburg Mozart Week.

The rich variety to be heard reflects the choir's commitment to the genre, whether in the ecstasy of Eriks Ešenvalds, the serenity of Jonathan Dove, the shimmering harmonies of Eric Whitacre, or the ethereal beauties of Paul Mealor.

Key Features:

- The performance of contemporary choral music has been central to the Vasari Singers' existence, flowing through its veins like lifeblood. So, when it came to settling on an idea for a 40th Anniversary recording, the choice of a collection of anthems by (mostly) living composers was a natural and obvious one.
- According to founder and conductor Jeremy Backhouse: 'We are proud of what we have achieved over 40 years, for the contribution we have made to the choral repertoire through our many commissions and our unwavering dedication to the promotion and performance of contemporary music. We sincerely hope this recording reflects that commitment.
- The Vasari Singers' first Naxos album, Great British Anthems on 8.572504, received the Gramophone 'Recommends' award with the magazine commenting: 'their timbre is always fresh and bright, and apt for this music.' 

Korngold's breathtaking precocity is everywhere in evidence in these two chamber masterpieces. The *Piano Trio* was composed when he was just twelve years old but its symphonic breadth and brilliantly demanding piano writing reveal myriad tonal colours and a mischievous reinvention of conventional Viennese form. Audacious yet rooted in lyricism, the *String Sextet* was written almost five years later and possesses memorable themes as well as a refined, theatrical intimacy. Spectrum Concerts Berlin has also recorded acclaimed discs of Hindemith (8.572213) and Toch (8.559324 and 8.559282) for Naxos.

Key Features:

- Spectrum Concerts Berlin is one of Germany's most significant voices in the world of chamber music and has specialised for Naxos in the music of expatriate German/Austrian composers. Their recording of Schulhoff's String Sextet (8.573525) was a MusicWeb International 'Recording of the Month' in December 2016: 'This is sometimes quite difficult music... [But] it is given a terrific performance here by a group of string players'.
- The Arensky chamber music disc (8.573317) received an ICMA Nomination, and an American Record Guide 'Critic's Choice': 'the Naxos is much better. There is more joy, more ecstasy, more élan, more tension, more shape to the phrases ... the buoyancy of the players on Naxos makes the music much more winsome.'
- The ensemble's other Naxos recordings include Hindemith's Clarinet Quintet (8.572213), which received an International Record Review 'Outstanding' award; Ernst Toch's Piano Quintet (8.559324), and Violin Sonata No. 1 and Cello Sonata (8.559716); Ursula Mamlok's String Quartet No. 1 and Polyphony I (8.559771); and Dohnányi's Serenade for String Trio and Sextet (8.557153), among others.
- Eldar Nebolsin enjoys a career as soloist, recitalist and chamber music player, appearing with conductors, orchestras and colleagues of international distinction. His Naxos album of Liszt's Piano Concertos Nos. 1 and 2, and Totentanz (8.570517) was a Gramophone 'Recommends' recipient: 'Nebolsin...is a virtuoso of power and poetry. While allowing the music to breathe he

The songs of Dmitry Shostakovich reflect the process of allusion and concealment that permeated his larger-scale music, and this selection traces his musical career from lighthearted early experiments to his late work. Settings of the composer's most loved poets are included, from Marina Tsvetayeva and Mikhail Lermontov to Shakespeare, as well as settings of Jewish folk poetry. The songs are richly varied and include cabaret-like moments, romantic balladry, the avantgarde and satirical subversion. Through the intimate medium of song Shostakovich managed to express the full range of his genius.

About Margarita Gritskova

Multi-award-winning Russian mezzo-soprano Margarita Gritskova is one of the leading singers of her generation. Since 2012 she has been a member of the ensemble at the Vienna State Opera. With her performance at the Vienna Opera Ball in February 2014, Gritskova caught the attention of an even larger international audience thanks to the worldwide television broadcast. She has given recitals at the Vienna Musikverein, Rossini in Wildbad and the Rossini Opera Festival in Pesaro. In 2017 she gave a series of recitals with pianist Maria Prinz in Sofia, Bulgaria and at the Russian Cultural Institute in Vienna.



Born in Lisbon of Italian parentage, Pedro António Avondano was employed at the court of Joseph I, becoming Portugal's leading composer of instrumental music and dances for the royal ballet. Il mondo della luna ('The World on the Moon') was a hugely successful libretto by Carlo Goldoni and was set by the likes of Haydn - its comic tale seeing the social climber and strict moralist Buona Fede duped into thinking that he is on the moon. This narrative of illusion in collision with love, jealousy and power struggles is set with sublime lyrical and dramatic transparency by Avondano in this, his only opera.

Key Features:

Os Músicos do Tejo, under artistic director Marcos Magalhães, is a highly successful Portuguese early music group founded in 2005. They have recorded From Baroque to Fado (8.573875), 'an unexpected pleasure as much for the high quality of performance throughout as well as the wide range of music included' (Lark Reviews), and two operas by Francisco António de Almeida: Il Trionfo d'Amore (8.573380-81) considered 'first class' by Early Music Today, and La Spinalba (8.660319-21), performed 'with stylistic distinction and pleasing clarity' (Opera News).





The release has a particularly strong cast of Portuguese singers. Tenor Fernando Guimarães (Ecclitico) was winner of the L'Orfeo International Singing Competition and works regularly with renowned Baroque ensembles and period opera productions all over the world. Awardwinning soprano Carla Caramujo (Lisetta) is hugely in demand for productions and performances of music from Baroque to contemporary premieres, and appearing on recordings including Pedro Macedo Camacho's Requiem Inês de Castro.

One of the pivotal and bloodiest battles of 16th-century Europe, the four-month siege of Malta by an Ottoman armada of some 200 ships, from which the local population led by the Knights of Malta emerged victorious, was an extraordinary episode of heroism overcoming overwhelming odds. Alexey Shor's orchestral cycle Images from the Great Siege allows his signature lyrical expressiveness free rein in a suite of romanticised impressions - from an atmospheric Premonition of the Ottoman invasion, to the daring and climactic The Big Bluff and final jubilant Victory Celebration. Verdiana is a virtuosic showpiece that celebrates and transforms Verdi's music into samba, bossa nova and tango styles.

Key Features:

Alexey Shor's attractive and accessible music has seen it performed at prestigious concert halls such as the Berlin Philharmonie, Carnegie Hall, Mariinsky Theatre (St Petersburg), Concertgebouw (Amsterdam), Wigmore Hall (London) and many others. This increasing profile and popularity can only be enhanced by this new orchestral recording with the renowned London Symphony Orchestra, in a programme that tackles the unusual theme of the Siege of Malta but in appealing music that views this remarkable event on a human scale and filled with romantic imagery. The fizzing inventiveness of Verdiana is the icing on top of what will turn out to be a rather delicious musical confection for Shor's many fans and those willing to explore.

Award-winning conductor Sergey Smbatyan's association with the London Symphony Orchestra stems from 2011, when he conducted the orchestra along with Valery Gergiev, Colin Davis and Riccardo Muti. He became principal conductor of the Malta Philharmonic Orchestra in 2019, and has worked previously with Alexey Shor in performances such as that of his Travel Notebook Concerto.



Nai-Chung Kuan's Memory of Mountain, originally a banhu concerto and here recast for the violin, is inspired by the magnificent scenery and culture of Taiwan's Alishan mountains, and explores three scenic topics employing native instruments to great effect. Joel Hoffman's music draws from such diverse sources as Eastern European folk music and American bebop, remaining full of lyricism and rhythmic vitality. Nautilus Symmetry, his first work for full Chinese orchestra. and Violin Concerto No. 2 'Snow in Spring', display a love of plucked string instruments and traditional Chinese melodies expressed in a style that is recognisably his own.

Key Features:

Cho-Liang Lin is an internationally renowned performer, a creator and curator of music festivals and a teacher. Recent concert engagements include numerous solo appearances worldwide with prestigious orchestras. An advocate of contemporary music, Lin has enjoyed collaborations and premieres with composers such as Esa-Pekka Salonen, Joan Tower and John Williams. On this recording Lin plays the 1715 'Titian' Stradivarius and a 2000 Samuel Zygmuntowicz violin.



Cho-Liang Lin's Naxos discography included the recently released Violin Sonatas by American composers John Harbison, Paul Schoenfeld and Steven Stucky (8.559888). He has also recorded Bright Sheng's Spring Dreams (8.570601), for which Lin was described as 'an accomplished player, amply trained in both cultures, and he makes as good a case for this music as possible' by AllMusic.com.

As one of the most prominent conductors in Taiwan, Li-Pin Cheng is noted for his vast repertoire and profound musical interpretations. His expertise in rehearsal direction has made him very popular among orchestral musicians. Since 2015, he has served as the general director of the Taipei Chinese Orchestra, leading the Orchestra in discovering new artistic horizons.

Alexander Rahbari's My Mother Persia is a cycle of symphonic poems suffused with the rich melodies, rhythms and improvisations of Persian traditional music in which he is profoundly versed both as composer and conductor. Originally written as a violin concerto, Symphonic Poem No. 9 'Nohe Khan' - the name relates to a singer at religious ceremonies - was recast for baritone saxophone in 2018. Symphonic Poem No. 10 'Morshed' vividly explores ritualised song in the context of 'ancient sport'. Volume 1 is on 8.574064 and Volume 2 on 8.574065.


Key Features:

- Alexander Rahbari is a remarkable figure in the music world, taking a leading position in the cultural development of his country from a young age, winning numerous awards as a conductor and becoming closely associated with the Berlin Philharmonic orchestra as assistant to Herbert von Karajan. Rahbari has conducted numerous successful Naxos recordings, but this is the world premiere release of his cycle of symphonic poems My Mother Persia.
- Vol. 1 included Symphonic Poems Nos. 1-3 (8.574064), in which American Record Guide commented: 'Rahbari's works embrace cultural openness in a world closed off by suspicion and fear. May we have more music like this.' Vol. 2 followed with Nos. 4-8 (8.574065), and praised by Fanfare: 'Rahbari is of course a most experienced orchestra leader, so one supposes the composer is getting what he wants from the conductor. Recommended as a worthwhile exploration of an exotic, foreign culture'.
- Alexander Rahbari conducts his own music in this recording, which always makes for a special listening experience. His many other Naxos recordings include highly praised accounts of Brahms' complete symphonies, and operas by Bizet, Leoncavallo, Mascagni, Puccini and Verdi, and a release of fellow Iranian Amir Tafreshipour's harp concerto Persian Echoes (8.579023).



Baroque violinist Augusta McKay Lodge has already established a reputation for seeking out unusual repertoire, and this new release includes world premiere recordings of sonatas by Giovanni Mossi as well as works by Giovanni Stefano Carbonelli, both of whom are virtually unknown in the current record catalogues.



Augusta McKay Lodge won the 2015 Juilliard Historical Performance Concerto Competition, and her subsequent solo recording Beyond Bach and Vivaldi (8.573893) gained wide critical acclaim, including a 10/10 score from ClassicsToday.com. It was also an AllMusic.com 'Editor's Choice': 'the performances are lively and witty, with a rhythmic verve that elevates the pieces above mere exercises. A delightful exploration of overlooked repertoire, this [album] offers intimate sound and crisp details which Baroque enthusiasts will relish.

Lodge has assembled a crack team of Baroque music specialists for her continuo ensemble, including cellist Ezra Seltzer, hailed for his 'scampering virtuosity' by American Record Guide. The recording has been made with an impressive collection of lovingly reproduced authentic period instruments.

Polish violist Krzysztof Komendarek-Tymendorf's debut solo album highlights two major works for the solo viola repertoire. Soviet composer Fyodor Druzhinin is a renowned violist with whom Shostakovich dedicated his Viola Sonata. His Sonata for Viola Solo, written in 1959, reveals Druzhunin to be a highly talented composer whose virtuoso treatment of the viola is second to none. Weinberg's close association with Druzhunin has also led to the compositions of the four Solo Viola Sonatas (No. 1 dedicated for and edited by Druzhunin), each piece having a unique and individual style from another. Sonata No. 3, Op. 135 combines technical and emotional challenges to the performer.

Key Features:

- Krzysztof Komendarek-Tymendorf is one of the most eminent Polish musicians of his generation. He comes from a family with deep musical traditions and is a descendant of the renowned Polish composer Michał Kleofas Ogiński.
- Komendarek-Tymendorf is a laureate of many music competitions, including First Place at the Macroregional Competition for Young Violists in Warsaw, the 25th Young Musician International Competition 'Città di Barletta' in Italy, and the Polish Rising Music Stars Competition. He has been invited to perform with the Lower Silesian Philharmonic, Cappella Gedanensis, Baltic Youth Philharmonic and the Chamber orchestra of the Stanisław Moniuszko Music Academy, under the baton of excellent conductors such as Pierre Boulez and Krzysztof Penderecki, among others. Komendarek-Tymendorf is the co-founder of the Balthus Quartet and Duo del Gesù.
- His performances were broadcasted by Deutsche Kultur Radio, Bayerischer Rundfunk, ORF Vienna Radio, Radio 1 (Poland) and on television, notably TVP 1 and Telewizja Polsat. Many contemporary works for viola were dedicated to him - Komendarek-Tymendorf has presented over 20 world premieres.
- The album was recorded on a master viola built by Gerhard Ernst in Eugen Sticht's luthier workshop in 1988.

J.S. Bach's Cello Suites are believed to have been written in the Saxon town of Cöthen between 1717 and 1723. They stand near the apex of Bach's compositions for a single instrument and contain some of his most beautiful and vivid writing. Jeffrey McFadden's quitar arrangements augment these elements with their own harmonic complexity, creating a new string medium for these epochal works. Volume 1, containing the first three suites, is on 8.573625. 'McFadden's ability to make the guitar sing is second to none' (Daily Telegraph, UK).

Key Features:

J.S. Bach's six Cello Suites have been arranged for guitar in the past, with Francisco Tárrega starting this tradition in the 19th century, followed by the likes of Andrés Segovia and John W. Duarte. Each new arrangement brings contemporary thinking and fresh insights and research, and Jeffrey McFadden's superb transcriptions have been applauded at numerous concert performances in which he was able to refine and hone his approach in advance of these recordings.



- Lark Reviews also commented on Vol. 1 (8.573625): 'Cello Suites 1, 2 & 3 arranged for guitar and here played with obvious enthusiasm and delight. While not having the nuance of the original it certainly conveys the joy of the works themselves and is able to communicate the varying moods of the original.
- McFadden recorded two instalments of Napoleon Coste's guitar works for Naxos (Vol. 1 on 8.554192). Vol. 4 (8.554354) received a 10/10 score from ClassicsToday.com: '... this is one of the loveliest discs in Naxos' burgeoning guitar collection.'

Josef Friedrich DOPPELBAUER (1918-1989) **Essential Works for Cello and Piano**

Martin Merker, Cello · Anna Adamik, Piano

Thirty-two years separate the oldest and most recent compositions on this album of selected works for cello and piano, covering a broad spectrum of Doppelbauer's artistic achievement. Extending from fateful weightiness to elegiac narrative and tender restraint, there is an impressive range of emotion in the Fantasie that forms the first movement of the Sonata for Violoncello and Piano WV 570, followed by a lively Rondo full of contrasts and a lyrical, melancholy Fuga with a reflective ending. The approach is quite different in the Prelude and Fugue WV 511, its harmonic patterns reminiscent of the organ, with a vigorous, almost Classical opening and a fugue ending fortissimo in a major key. The Three Sonatas for solo violoncello WV 559 explore the entire register of the cello and impose great technical demands on the performer.

Key Features:

- Josef Friedrich Doppelbauer is now numbered among the most important Austrian composers of the 20th century. The composer left a large body of work embracing almost all genres and running to almost 600 titles.
- Anna Adamik is professor for piano at the Vorarlberg Regional Conservatory in Feldkirch, West Austria. She studied at the universities of music in Budapest, Vienna and Freiburg with Tamás Fülep, Annamária Krause, Paul Badura-Skoda and Ramón Walter.
- Martin Merker is the solo cellist of the argovia philharmonic, a member of CAMERATA BERN and cellist of the Offenburg String Trio. He has won prizes at numerous international chamber music competitions. The cellist studied at the music universities of Detmold, Basel and Barcelona with Karine Georgian, Reinhard Latzko, Ivan Monighetti and Lluis Claret. He teaches in Liechtenstein.



Anna Adamik and Martin Merker have been appearing in concert since 2001 in many of the nations of Europe. Concert tours have taken them to Asia and to the USA.

Domenico SCARLATTI (1685–1757) Complete Keyboard Sonatas Vol. 25

Pascal Pascaleff, Piano

Scarlatti's single-movement sonatas or exercises are his greatest musical legacy. Largely designed for the Infanta, who became Queen of Spain in 1746, the music exists in a number of 18th-century manuscripts, some possibly bequeathed to the great Italian castrato Farinelli. Each of the sonatas in this volume exemplifies the limitless variety of Scarlatti's imagination, from 'crush' notes and surprising pauses, through virtuosic *moto perpetuos*, bell evocations and busy counterpoint, to delicately restrained phrases and delightful syncopation.



In the world of music, focus points and fashion styles may come and go, but examining the possibilities and the art of tahe trio still remains one of the central activities in jazz. How can the mere fact that three people meet and make music on three basic instruments – piano, double bass, drums – still give us such massive excitement, both as musicians and listeners? 




